SEA TRIALS DISNEY DESTINY: HINTS

The conveyance and sea trial of the Disney Destiny (S 706) starts. Here is an overview of the instructions determined together with the works council.

Registration for on-board access (cabin/daily visitor)

Registration for on-board access can only be requested through the person responsible from the yard (MEYER WERFT). Boarding passes will not be issued without prior registration.

All individuals assigned to a cabin on board must watch the safety film in advance. Proof of this will be indicated by a sticker on the boarding pass. Without this sticker, access to the vessel is not permitted.

Accommodation on board

There will be bed linen and towels in the cabins. Disney provides the housekeeping service and will clean the cabin and wet room 2x weekly. Washing private laundry and work clothes will be possible on board, for partners in the Coffee Shop Deck 1 FZ 6 and for the Meyer employees on deck 8 in the PAX Launderette. Please note that no detergent is dispensed. Therefore, please bring your own detergent. There is also no longer a laundry container in Eemshaven.

To ensure that we do not block any cabins unnecessarily, we reserve the right to vacate and reassign cabins of people who have not been on board for more than 48 hours without deregistration with our hotel team. Please remember to check out when you finally leave your cabin. This is possible in the hotel container at the pier or at the gangway.

Bus shuttle service

To make the bus ride to Eemshaven as comfortable as possible for everyone, we have once again arranged a shuttle service between the festival site in Papenburg and Eemshaven.

Registration at least 48 hours in advance is required to enable better planning.

For cost reasons, please avoid renting company vehicles and use the shuttle service provided.

Bus departure times will be published on the website / channel and displayed on board.

Please note: A bus ride is only possible with a valid boarding pass.

We recommend using the service to pick up your boarding pass in advance at the hotel container in Papenburg. Your boarding pass will be scanned when entering the bus.

Berth

It is mandatory to wear a safety vest and helmet on the entire site. Please remember helmets and vests, they will not be kept in stock and handed out in Eemshaven. This time, only the parking lot at the Seafarers' Mission is available. This means that parking spaces are limited.

Catering

Catering on board will take place on board, for MW & Partner the food court DK 11 FZ02 STB applies. Information about the times and the groups will be announced with notices on board. The Crew and Officers' Mess is exclusively for Disney employees!

If you have known food intolerances, it is best to contact the hotel in advance. We will then get you in contact with the caterer or the Owner!

Twice a day, a water disposal (max. 4 bottles per day of still water & mineral water) is handed out in a container outside the ship. (During conveyance and sea trial, the water distribution will take place on DK 33 FZ 2)

At the beginning, everyone receives 4 tokens, which can be exchanged for 4 bottles, afterwards empty bottles can be exchanged.

Important: Queues are always influenced by employee behavior. The concept will only work if everyone adheres to their assigned mealtimes.

A separate coffee corner will be available for all employees on board (Deck 11, FZ 4 SB). Please note that the location might change. Follow the announcements on board or contact our hotel team for updates.

This service can only be maintained if it is treated with care and respect.

Internet and television

We as a shipyard provide Wifi, which can be used by the entire Meyer Werft team. Streaming movies will not be possible, staying in touch via social networks will work. The prerequisite for this is that we as a shipyard complete the systems on time, same for the TVs inside the cabins. External devices are forbidden.

What is not allowed?

Drugs, alcohol, and weapons are strictly prohibited on board.

Persons who seem to be intoxicated will be asked for a breath alcohol test. The maximum permitted blood alcohol level for access to the ship or port area is 0.3‰ (per mille).

Alcohol consumption is not permitted anywhere on the Wagenborg premises or on board.

Technical devices such as kettles, game consoles, irons, etc. are not allowed.

Shavers, straighteners, curling irons and hair dryers are allowed, but should be packed again after use.

Smoking is not allowed in the cabins and outside the designated areas. It's not allowed to walk around the vessel with open containers like cups or glasses.
